

## SCHOOL BOARD APPOINTMENT

Trustee Dewine Moore has submitted his resignation to the Southern Kern Unified School District Board effective March 13, 2024.

As a result of the resignation, the Board of Trustees determined they would make a provisional appointment to fill the vacancy by advertising, interviewing, and selecting an individual for the vacant position.

The District asks individuals interested in serving on the Southern Kern Unified School District Board of Trustees to submit a letter of intent to the Southern Kern Unified School District Superintendent's Office by **3:00 p.m., April 5, 2024**, with the following information:

- 1) Why are you interested in serving as a member of the Southern Kern Unified School District Board of Trustees?
- 2) What experience and qualities would you bring to the Board?
- 3) What significant information would you like the Board to know or what issues do you feel are important to the District?

The Board will conduct interviews on the evening of April 10, 2024, and an appointment will be made at the Board meeting on April 10, 2024. These dates and this appointment conform with the legal requirements set by California Education Code 5091.

Note: Unless a petition calling for a special election containing a sufficient number of signatures is timely filed with the County Superintendent, the provisional appointment shall become an effective appointment. The petition must be filed within 30 days of the date of the provisional appointment.
