



## Dual Enrollment requirements of Rosamond High Early College Campus Students attending AVC Classes for Fall 2021 Term

Students must complete an *online* application at AVC.edu **every semester**. From the AVC homepage; click APPLY at top of the page, then click on (1) Apply Online to begin enrollment.

*(As a Dual Enrolled RHSECC/AVC student you must complete the AVC online application every semester.)*

Upon completion of the application, you will receive a confirmation email from AVC. On this email, AVC will confirm you successfully registered for Fall 2021 term, provide your AVC ID #, myAVC account information, and next steps for enrollment. *(RHECC Counselors/Staff will submit enrollment documents to AVC)*

**Forward a copy of the AVC confirmation email to your Counselor. AVC wants a copy to verify that you have successfully applied for the current semester.**

1. Complete the AVC Online Orientation. (Go to AVC homepage; click APPLY at top of the page, click #3- Complete Online Orientation)
2. Students must complete a Special Student Admittance Form for each semester of attendance, signed by parent/guardian and student. Turn in to the RHECC office or scan and email to your Counselor. Printed copies of this form are also available in the office.
3. Counselor will provide a copy of your unofficial high school transcript
4. Students *under the age of 15* must meet with the Dean of Counseling before registering for a class. A parent or guardian must also participate in the meeting. AVC will contact the parent to schedule a meeting.
5. AVC requires a GPA of 2.5 on Student transcripts if the student will be taking 6 units or less per semester.
6. AVC requires a GPA of 3.0 on Student transcripts if the student will be taking 7 -11 units per semester.
7. College classes are ***NOT FREE***. Students should apply for the California College Promise Grant (If you do not qualify for the California College Promise Grant, you can create a payment plan through your myAVC account.)
8. Southern Kern Unified School District will cover the cost of Rosamond High School student's books up to \$1000.00 while attending RHECC. ***Special note, any withdrawals/drops/failures in college classes will constitute NO reimbursement*** for college book costs to RHECC .To receive reimbursements for college books, students **must receive a C or better** in their College class(s). Parent/Guardian (s) will be required to fill out a W-9 form, a reimbursement form, college book agreement form, and have the original receipt for the book. (Forms are available from Mrs. Benson in the main office)
9. In many cases a student may borrow a textbook from Rosamond High School.

**If a student borrowed the book from SKUSD at the College Center** students will be charged the rental cost of the borrowed book if they DO NOT pass their class with a C or better or if they drop/withdraw from the class.

**June 23, 2021 at 8:00 am** is the Fall 2021 open registration date. To register for classes you must have completed all enrollment steps above. You will need to register online for classes during Open Registration using your myAVC account. Instructions and support will be provided for this process.

### **Special Notes:**

- *Students may enroll for class between June 23rd and the first day of a class. Classes begin the week of August 16th. Students are encouraged to register as soon as possible due to class size limitations.*
- *Be aware of drop dates for classes; if you do not drop within the first two weeks of class you will be responsible for all fees.*
- *After enrollment, be sure to pay your fees, AVC will drop students **DAILY** for non-payment of any and all fees owed.*
