

Notice of Grievance Procedures

The Southern Kern Unified School District does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, disability (including harassment), or age in its programs and activities.

Parents and Guardians have the right to file a complaint of discrimination, including disability discrimination and peer harassment, to the Associate Superintendent.

Any student who feels that he/she has been subjected to discrimination, harassment, intimidation, or bullying should immediately contact the principal or the Associate Superintendent. In addition, any student who observes any such incident should report the incident to the principal or Associate Superintendent, whether or not the victim files a complaint.

Upon receiving a complaint of discrimination, harassment, intimidation, or bullying, the Associate Superintendent will immediately investigate the complaint in accordance with the District's Unified Complaint Procedures as specified in AR 1312.3 – Uniform Complaint Procedures or through the District's internal process.
